

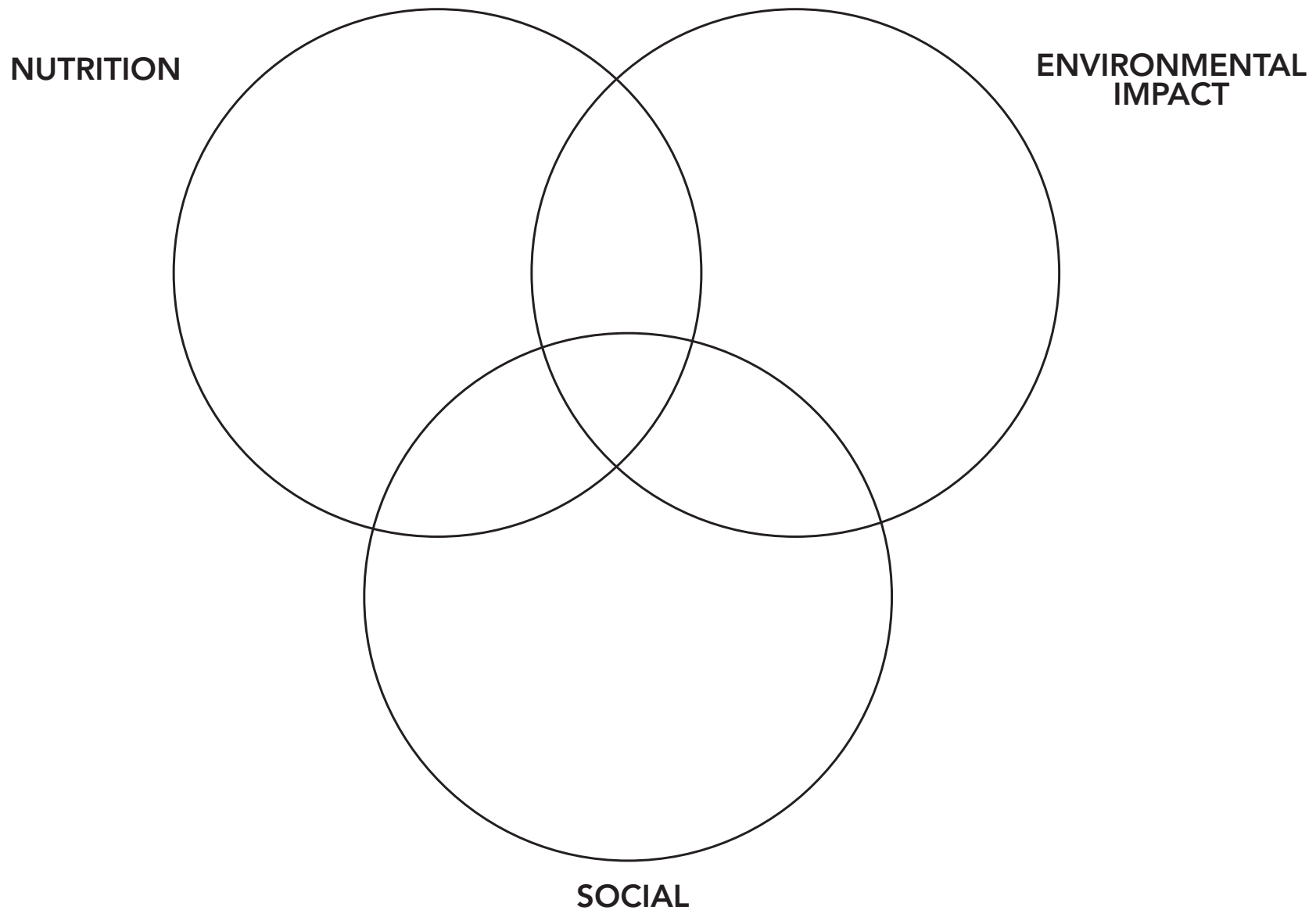
Choose the Yogurt

Yogurt brand	Nutrition information	Brand description
	Protein: 8g Carbohydrate: 4g Fat: 3.5g Added Sugar: 3g	Brand A yogurt uses milk from cows on family-owned farms. Cows on these farms are pastured-raised and eat a majority grass diet. Farmers who supply milk and farmers who harvest strawberries are paid fair-liveable wages. Brand A also donates 10% of profits toward nutrition education programs in public schools.
	Protein: 5g Carbohydrate: 11g Fat: 3g Added Sugar: 10g	Brand B yogurt is committed to producing yogurt sustainably. They help conventional farmers learn about and implement farming practices that maintain nutrient levels in the soil. Brand B yogurt company also donates 10% of their profits to environmental organizations.
	Protein: 10g Carbohydrate: 5g Fat: 2g Added Sugar: 4g	Brand C yogurt uses completely compostable packaging and is committed to reducing waste and using 30% less water and 25% less power during the yogurt production process within the next 5 years of operation.
	Protein: 15g Carbohydrate: 8g Fat: 4g Added Sugar: 7g	Brand D partners with farmers who prioritize and embrace growing and harvesting methods that regenerate and restore the resources in the land rather than depleting them. Small batch production with high quality ingredients also ensures taste and nutritional standards are met.
	Protein: 10g Carbohydrate: 4g Fat: 3g Added Sugar: 2g	Brand E yogurt is a local brand and only uses ingredients from local farms and works with farmers to use imperfect looking strawberries that would otherwise be unable to be sold. Brand E also uses honey from local bee farms to sweeten their yogurt rather than high fructose corn syrup.
